

HSA Class Action
Update – July 25, 2016

The British Columbia Court of Appeal issued Reasons for judgment on July 25, 2016. A copy can be found **here**. The Court refused to grant the application of the HSA and the Trustees to strike out the claim in its entirety. The Court of Appeal did strike out some parts of the claim. However, the effect of the Court of Appeal's judgment is to keep the class action against the HSA and the Trustees alive.

Once we have finalized the Court's formal order, we will be mailing a formal notice to potential class members asking them whether they wish to opt in to [participate in] the class action (automatic if you are living in British Columbia) or to opt out (if you live outside of British Columbia you need to contact us within a time set by the Court in order to opt in).

Once the form of the opt in / opt out notice has been approved by the Court we will also put a copy up on this website.
